

### **Impact of Pupil Premium Provision 2014/15**

The Pupil Premium Grant has enabled targeted children in Year 6 to attain national expectations in reading, writing, maths and GPS, not only narrowing the gap but exceeding it.

Pupil premium children, where appropriate have been given uniform, P.E. kits and book backs to insure that they are fully integrated into school.

Breakfast club subsidy for identified children has led to improved punctuality and attendance.

100% of the children attending Lledr Hall, eligible for PP, received a grant of £120 towards the cost. One child received a full grant. All other trips are subsidised to ensure that all children are included.
