P.E Kits

Parent Money

If you choose to pay weekly please ensure the school office receives payment each **Monday morning**. Late payments will result in parents being asked to provide a packed lunch for their child/ren.

Free School Meals

Parent money for September was due before we broke up for the summer. Milk is £9.60; this is for the whole term until Christmas. If your child is under 5 or entitled to free school dinners you do not need to pay. If you think you may be entitled to free School Meals please telephone 0161 909 6508 (**This does not include infant children who are provided with a school meal under the new government legislation**).
