Dinner Money

Milk Money

Milk is £8.30; this is for the whole term until summer. If your child is under 5 or entitled to free school dinners you do not need to pay. If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals please telephone 0161 793 2500 (**This does not include infant children who are provided with a school meal under the new government legislation**).
