Dinner money

Milk Money

Message from Mr Hutson

Next half terms P.E for Years 3, 4 5 and 6 will be Rugby and Dance. Therefore your child(ren) will need both an outdoor and indoor P.E kit with them everyday.

Salford Red's will be doing Years 3 and 4 Rugby and it starts the first week back so it will be needed that week. Indoor P.E kit is black shorts, white t-shirt, and pumps.

Outdoor P.E kit is black shorts, white t-shirt, a tracksuit or jumper and joggers to put on over the top, trainers or football boots (no metal studs), hats and scarves.

If your child doesn't have an outdoor P.E kit they will not be allowed to join in with the Rugby for health and safety reasons. Pumps are not safe on muddy ground so trainers are essential.
